- To remove the risks of accidents and 'lost days' in the workplace.

Who for?

All levels of personnel within all types of business, Managers/Supervisors and ground level employees. Ideal as part of induction - and as refresher training.

Course Content

- Health & Safety at Work Act 1974
- EEC Regulations 1992 - 6 pack, Management of Health & Safety, Manual Handling, Personal Protective Equipment, Provision and Use of Work Equipment, Display Screen Equipment, Work Place Health, Safety and Welfare.
- Reporting of Injuries, Diseases and Dangerous Occurrences Regulations
- First Aid at Work Regulations
- Electricity at Work Regulations
- COSHH Regulations
- Fire Regulations
- Employee's duties of compliance

Training Method

Highly participative classroom based, highlighted by the use of Overhead Projector, Videos and Handouts, incorporating a written test paper.

Courses can be carried out in U.T.N. Training Centre, or carried out on customers premises, where a room with electrical supply for Television, Video and Overhead Projector can be used.
