

2 Day Advanced Scaffold Inspection

Objectives

- Introduction to risk assessment for scaffolding.
- Scaffolding fault finding exercise.
- End test.

This course can be delivered on client's premises depending on the facilities and delegate numbers. An area set aside from the normal working area will be required along with a suitable scaffold for the practical session.

Scaffolds covered on this course

- Truss out & cantilever drop
- Slung (tubular & wire) & raking shore (push & pull)
- Temporary roof & protection fans
- Staircases & falsework
- Loading bays & edge protection
