Objectives

- NVQ Level 3 and a CISRS card.

Who for

Scaffolders who have held their Basic Scaffolder card for a minimum of 1 year.

Course content

At the end of the course, the trainee should be able to:-

- Erect scaffolds in accordance with drawings and specifications.
- System erect system falsework.
- Erect and dismantle correctly—a tubular hanging & raking shore

At the end of the course, the trainee should know:-

- The types and uses of scaffold fittings.
- Tubes and boards in common use.
- Construction and statutory regulations relevant to the erection and dismantling of basic complex and designed structures.
- How to interpret and correctly read scaffolding drawings and specifications.

Training method

A highly participative course with practical sessions to complement the classroom theory session.

NOTE: In addition to receiving a certificate of training, successful candidates are also able to achieve S/NVQ Level 3 scaffolding.

This course will be carried out at our own CITB approved training centre.
