- Birdcage Scaffold.
- Static Tower.
- Mobile Tower.
- Hoist Tower.
- Proprietary Systems.
- Roof/saddle/stack.
- Getting the knowledge and skill to be able to safely dismantle the scaffolds in their correct sequence, as a member of a team.

Training Method

A highly participative course with practical sessions to complement classroom theory session.

This course will be carried out at our own CITB approved training centre.

Additional Information

Delegates attending this course will achieve a trainee card. To progress their training, delegates will need to return after six months and attend a ten day Basic Part 2 course. Six months later delegates will need to attend a one-day assessment.

This training along with their completed and signed off NVQ Level 2 portfolio will ultimately gain them a basic Scaffolders card.
