## National Certificate In Construction Health & Safety

### Objectives

On completion of the training trainees attending will have the skills and knowledge to identify procedures and systems within their organisation to minimise the risk to persons within the organisation and the skills to develop safe working procedures.

### Who for

Persons who have gained the relevant qualifications prior to the start of this course and have responsibilities for the day to day control of health and safety and have duties to assist in the management of health and safety within a construction environment. The qualification is also appropriate for supervisors and managers working in other industries such as utilities, and even broadcasting where temporary workplaces are a features of their activities.

### Course Content

- Unit 1—Management of health & safety.
- Unit 2—Managing and controlling hazards in construction activities.
- Unit 3—Construction Health & Safety practical application.

### Training Method

Students are assessed with written examinations for NGC1 and NCC1. NCC2 is assessed by a practical examination testing the ability to identify health and safety issues in a construction workplace. NCC2 needs to be taken within 14 days of the written examination. A unit of credit is issued denoting successful completion of all three units.

### Additional Information

This course meets the criteria for CITB grants. CITB registered companies will be able to claim £26.00 per person per day for this course (**except exam days**). The UTN administration team will give full support for the application of this grant.
