COURSE EXTENDED TO COVER NEW LAWS

Updated legislation covering working at height, along with new industry standards, has meant an extension of our Scaffold Inspection course from one to two days.

The changes include updated Working at Height Regulations; TG20:05, the NASC new guidelines following changes to EN12811-1; along with SG4:05, new guidelines on preventing falls in Scaffolding and Falsework.

Designed for all supervisors and managers responsible for inspecting, recording and signing off scaffold structures, it includes classroom sessions on legislative requirements, and a practical session to compliment the theory.

The new course is proving so popular it is already booked up for January and February and extra dates are being programmed.

The course meets the criteria for CITB grant for registered companies of £35 per person per day.



Time running out for Scaffold ARE

Anyone wanting to get their CISRS card through the ARE route need to book their course quickly as time is running out.

There is now less than six months before the Assessed Route of Entry (ARE) for Basic and Advanced Scaffolders ceases to exist. After June 30 all scaffolders wanting their CISRS card will have to go through the same full training programme as a beginner rather than a 4/5 day assessment.

Already UTN are virtually booked up until the end of March and can take limited numbers for the remaining three months.

“There will be a lot of dissatisfied scaffolders who fail to get on the courses available”, said UTN Centre Manager, Dave Roberts.

SMSTS CERTIFICATES
