NRSA SIGNING, LIGHTING & GUARDING QUALIFICATION

(UNITS 002 & 010)

Signing, Lighting & Guarding (unit 002 or 010) has always been a standalone course within the NRSA structure. City & Guilds Certification has always been issued for candidates successfully completing the course.

There is now a change! Candidates can now obtain an ID card issued by Scotvec.

If you currently hold either the unit 002 or 010 certification you can apply to have the new card.

Candidates have until April 6th 2011 to make this application, after this date all existing qualifications will be null & void unless you hold the new card.

Candidates who miss this deadline will have to sit the full course again

Applicants will need to fill in the form and return it to Scotvec along with 1 passport photo and the relevant fee of £21.50 and a copy of your original certificate
